

## The Rules

- Consent must be given freely by everyone involved, every time that means you are both OK with the sexy touching you are talking about.
- Consent can be taken away at any time, even if you are in a relationship.
- Consent can't be given freely if someone is pressured or threatened.
- Consent can't be given if someone is asleep or affected by alcohol or drugs.
- How do you know you have consent? Ask them! Is this OK with you? Can I do this?
  If you don't have a clear Yes, it means No.
- Sexy touching without consent is sexual assault and is against the law.
- Talk to a trusted adult if anything doesn't feel OK.
